 - School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)

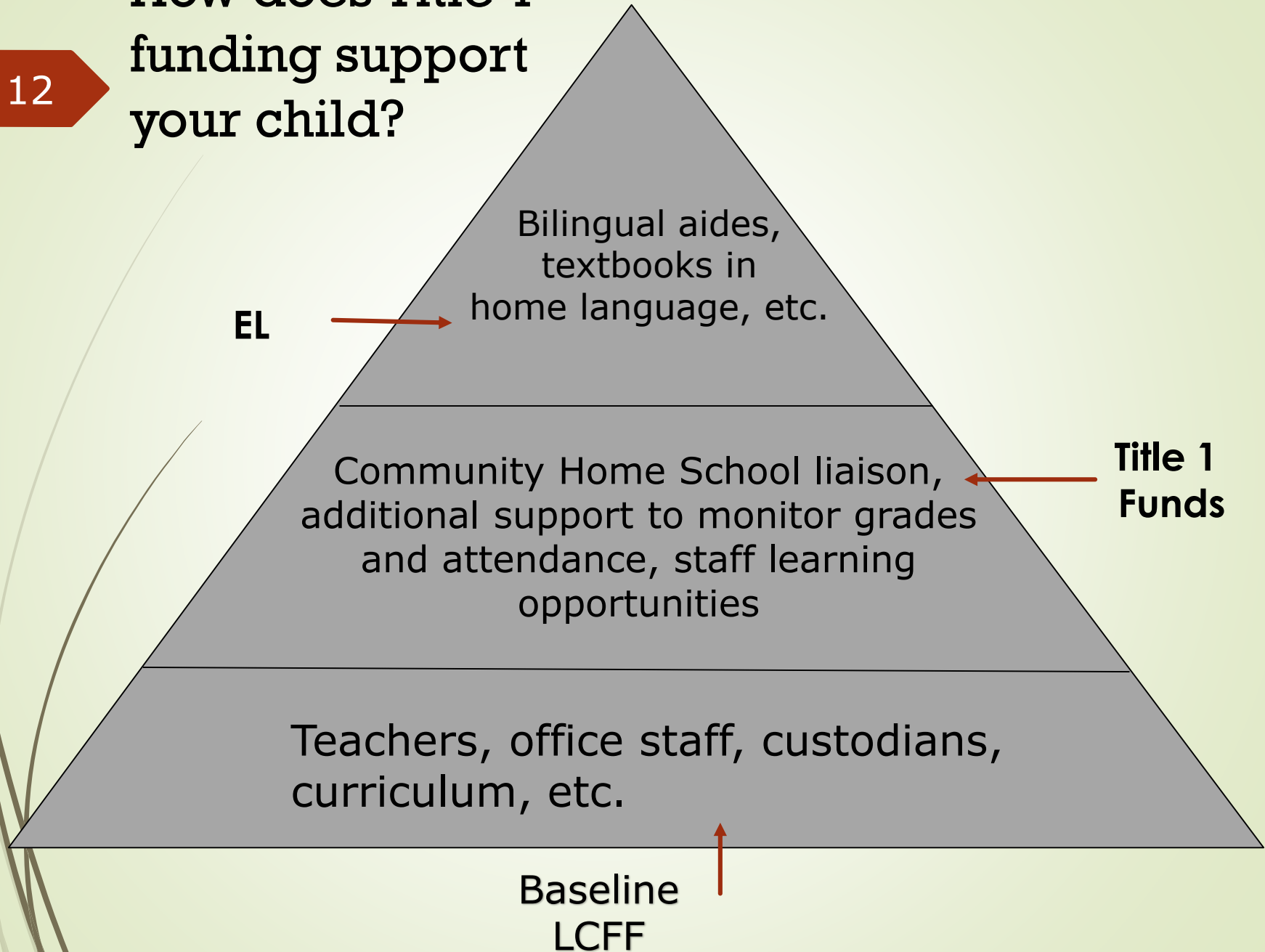
Title I Funds in the Public Schools

How does Title 1 funding support your child?

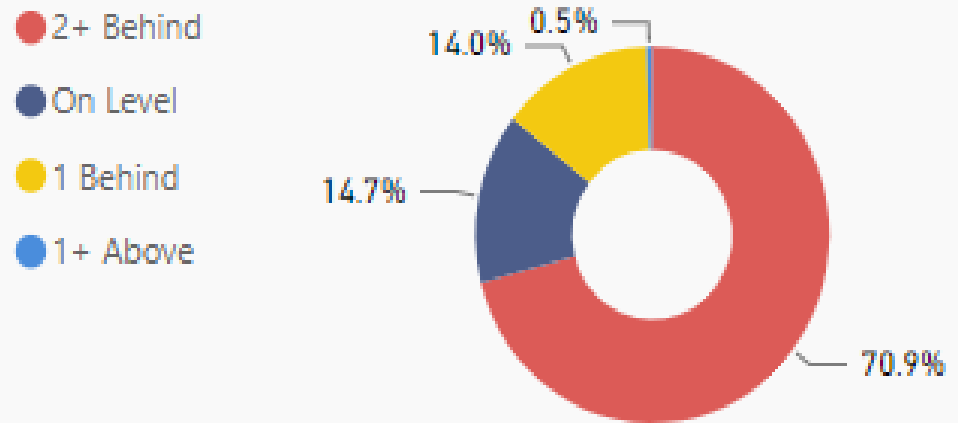

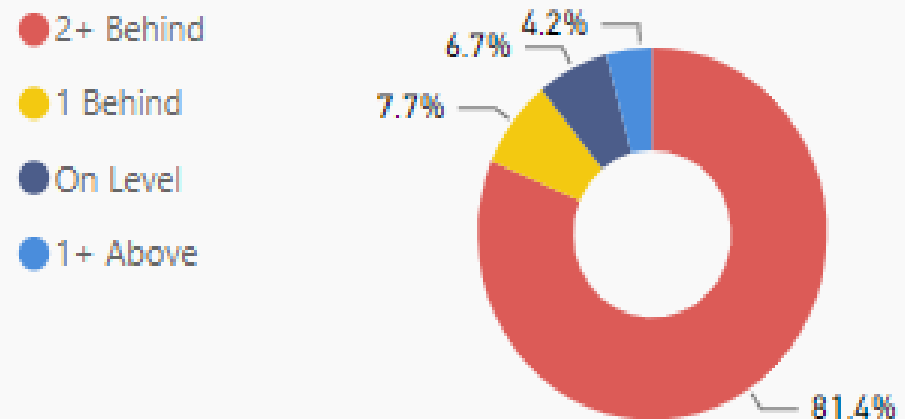

D1 Prior Year (2020-21)



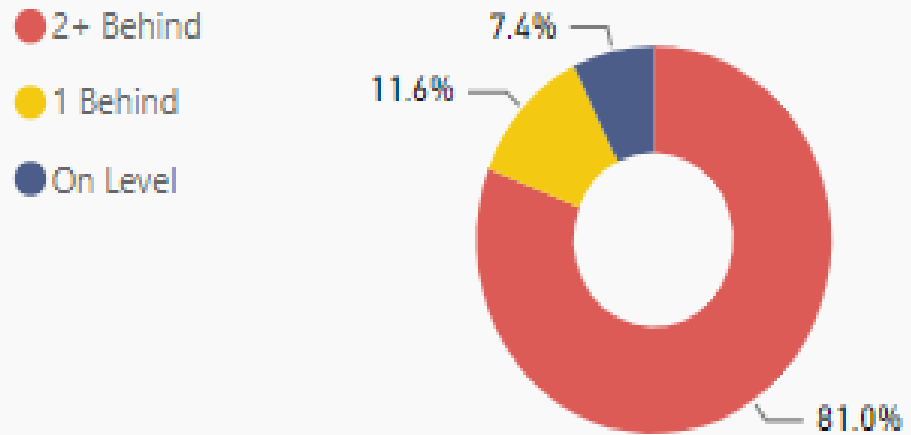
D1 Current Year (2021-22)



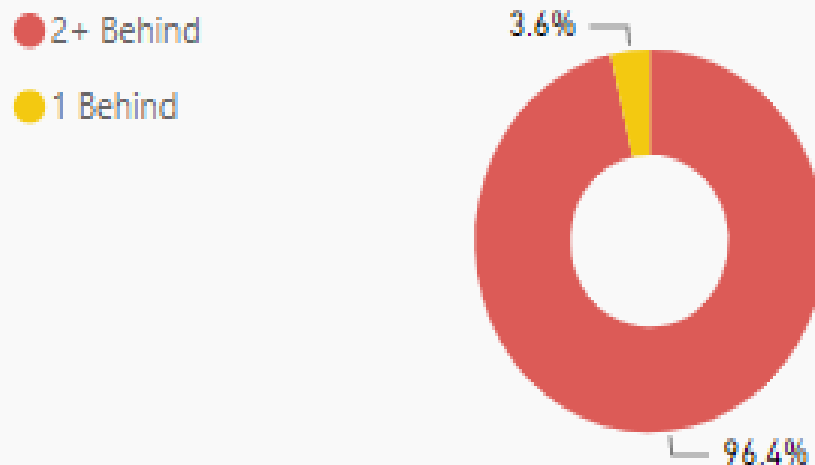
